1943

We regret to record the death of Sir Charles Hyde, Bart., one of the Founders of the School.

Sir Kinalhan Cornwallis, G.C.M.G., British Ambassador in Baghdad, has been elected a Vice-President.

The accounts are annexed. The income was £917, and the expenditure £35. Mr. Harold Lakeman has once more kindly audited the accounts without fee.

The activities of the School having been suspended, almost the whole of the income is available for investment, and the increased resources thus accumulated will strengthen our capacity to undertake excavation or other archaeological work after the war.

Pending a resumption of work, the Executive Committee is not asking for donations, but it appeals to Members for bequests to the School.
